APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Applicants must be a resident of Staten Island and accepted to (full- or part-time) an accredited curriculum of study in a course of study leading to a degree. Preference will be given to applicants who are returning to school after an interruption of 5 or more years, or who have returned to school after such a break within the last 2 years.

Applicants must submit:

- (1) NYSW-RC Scholarship Cover Sheet
- (2) Applicant Resume including employment and/or community service history.
- (3) Two (2) letters of reference from unrelated individuals (such as, teacher, employer, community group supervisor, or religious leader).
- (4) A typed, double-spaced essay (250-500 words) discussing your goals and how the receipt of this scholarship award would help you to aspire to achieve them.
- (5) Proof of acceptance and registration at an accredited school*.

The completed application form with all necessary attachments must be received electronically by the **deadline of March 22, 2016 at 11:59 pm.**

- (4) A typed, double-spaced essay (250-500 words) discussing your personal goals and how the receipt of this financial grant would help you to aspire to achieve them.
- (5) Proof of acceptance and registration at an accredited school*.
